To further enhance this special wine experience, a variety of wineries will be offering delicious pairings of wine and food and a number of Waterfront restaurants will also take part. Also, to sample and for sale will be a host of delicacies including French and local cheeses, oysters, sushi, Thai noodles, carpaccio, charcuterie, biltong, spring rolls, olives and olive oils, mussels, pestos, preserves, chocolates, and nougat.

A number of Waterfront eateries will be offering special Wine Affair dinners during this period. And this year a portion of ticket sales will be donated to The Pebbles Project, a charity offering educational support to children with special needs, in the Cape Winelands.
